Wednesday – September 28, 2022

While many cities choose to pave over the past, the streets of Richmond are a constant reminder of our nation's sometimes turbulent, always fascinating history. Sit back and relax as you board the coach for an educational day in Richmond. Learn what makes this city so historic and learn of the new renovations that make for a promising future. This tour features an overview of Richmond's historical and cultural attractions with a knowledgeable and friendly local guide. On this tour, you will see Richmond's graciously restored neighborhoods to include: historic Downtown, site of Thomas Jefferson's Capitol; Shockoe Slip, a cobblestone restaurant district; Church Hill, noted for its unique cast iron patterns and site of St. John's Church, original location of Patrick Henry's famous and passionate "Liberty or Death" speech (we will tour here); and Jackson Ward, known as the Black Wall Street and the Harlem of the South. Learn about Hollywood Cemetery, a 135-acre Victorian landscaped cemetery high on the bluffs above the James River. It is the final resting place of U.S. Presidents Monroe and Tyler; Confederate President, Jefferson Davis and his family; 25 Confederate generals; 18,000 Confederate enlisted men; and many

other notables. Enjoy a visit to the Virginia War Memorial, built in the 1950's to honor those Virginians who have given the ultimate sacrifice to protect our freedoms. Lunch is included mid-day at the historic John Marshall Hotel. First opened in 1929, it was one of the leading hospitality establishments in downtown Richmond, Virginia. **\$150**

Annual Fall Spectacular

Staunton, VA

Saturday – October 22, 2022

In the heart of the Shenandoah Valley, Staunton, Virginia offers old fashioned Americana at its best. It is located along the "Great Wagon Road" between the Blue Ridge and the Alleghenies. It has often been on the list for "Best Small Towns in America" and is one of five US cities that has won the prestigious Great American Main Street Awards by The National Trust for Historic Preservation – towns recognized for their commercial district revitalization efforts. Start your day with a tour of the birthplace of the 28th president of the United States, Woodrow Wilson Presidential Museum and Library. Interpreters will take you back to 1856 when Wilson was born and discuss his family, upbringing, and the lifestyle of the





period. The house has been restored to its appearance when Reverend Joseph Wilson and his family lived there including twelve recreated rooms in the former president's home containing many items belonging to the Wilsons. Visitors may then proceed with a self-guided tour of the museum and explore President Wilson's life through seven galleries. The museum also features the President's original 1919 Pierce-Arrow limousine and a recreated World War I trench complete with lights and sound. A delicious lunch buffet of breaded shrimp, chicken and pork tenderloin is included mid-day at Mrs. Rowe's. Next, a professional step-on guide joins you for a Guided, Riding Tour that will include five of the six historic districts of Staunton. Learn about the architectural significance of so many of the homes and buildings. Visit historic Trinity Episcopal Church to view the 12 Tiffany windows and beautiful interior. **\$190**

SignaTours does offer Trip Insurance for all tours and cruises with the exception of our one day tours. Information is included with your tour confirmation. While we offer Insurance, we are not experts in the field, so we defer any and all questions to the Insurance Carrier – NTA (A Product of Berkely Care) Contact information for Berkely Care is provided within the brochure sent.

1. Covers You Before Your Cruise or Tour – Purchasing travel insurance can cover you if you need to cancel your trip before your cruise or tour. Most cruise lines and tour operators have a cancellation charge if cancelled within 30 to 60 days of the departure date – within 30 days it's usually 100% of the cruise or tour cost. With travel insurance, you are protected in the event of a sickness, injury, job loss etc. Some insurance policies will even let you cancel for any reason up until 48 hours before your departure date.

2. Covers You on the Way to Your Cruise or Tour – Travel insurance also covers trip interruptions, lost luggage, and trip and baggage delays. This can be extremely valuable if you are flying in on the morning of your cruise and your flight gets delayed. Most even cover the cost if involved in an accident traveling to the departure point.

3. Covers You During Your Cruise or Tour – You will be covered for any medical emergencies that you have while on tour. Your HMO/PPO or Medicare may not cover you if you are traveling outside the United States, and you also likely won't be covered if you need an emergency evacuation.
