Named by the *Abenaki Indians*, meaning "Beautiful Place by the Sea," Ogunquit boasts spectacular views of the coastline and its white sand beaches and is truly one of the prettiest places on the *Southern Coast of Maine*. A delicious *Dinner* completes your fun-filled day of travel. The remainder of the evening is yours to enjoy the surroundings of this fabulous *Resort* property.

Boston - Coastal Maine - Ogunquit

Wednesday - September 27th: (Breakfast/Dinner)

Ogunquit – Boothbay Harbor – Rockland

Thursday - September 28th: (Breakfast/Dinner)

Marvel at the breathtaking 360-degree views of the Penobscot River Bay. A stop will be made for lunch on your own midday. This afternoon arrive at *Mount Desert Island* and check into the *Kimball Terrace Inn* in *Northeast Harbor!* Settle in and unwind before a tasty *Dinner* this evening.

Rockland – Northeast Harbor

Friday - September 29th: (Breakfast/Dinner)

Today is all about beauty, majesty, and picturesque views to last a lifetime, but not before enjoying a hearty *Breakfast* at your hotel. Say hello to your *Friendly Guide* once again as you board the coach and set off for a magnificent tour through one of America's most beautiful and treasured *National Parks...* *Acadia National Park*. There is so much to see and do at this incredible *National Park* that is famous not only for its abundant beauty but also for its rich human history dating back more than 10,000 years with the *Wabanaki* people, the fur traders and European explorers of the 17th century and the influence of wealth and tourism of the 19th and 20th centuries!

Highlights of the day, in addition to the many picturesque stops along the way, include *Thunder Hole*, *Cadillac Mountain*, *Frenchman's Bay*, *Porcupine Islands*, and more! Enjoy free time for shopping and lunch on your own in the beautiful village of *Bar Harbor*, gateway to the mountains and cliffs of *Acadia National Park*. The excitement builds this afternoon as you embark on a *Scenic Nature Cruise* out of *Frenchman Bay*. Your cruise allows you to discover the panoramic views of Acadia, islands, lighthouses, and the beautiful coastline. You also have the perfect vantage point to witness the extensive wildlife such as porpoises, seals, and the many varieties of seabirds. Your remarkable day ends with a delicious *Lobster Feast*. Bar Harbor – Portland – Kennebunkport - Portsmouth

Your afternoon includes a scenic drive into *Kennebunkport, Maine* made famous in the 1600's for its ship building and the five-masted ships and schooners that made their way down the river and out to sea. It was also quite famous for the fine mansions built by Sea Captains, many of which are preserved today as lovely inns with antique charm. More recently, however, *Kennebunkport* is a thriving resort town and summer home of *President George H.W. Bush*. You'll see the president's home as you drive along the coastline to *Walker's Point*, residence of the Bush family for decades. Free time follows in *Kennebunkport's Dock Square* before continuing to *Portsmouth, New Hampshire* for an early evening check-in at the *Holiday Inn*. A wonderful farewell *Dinner* is planned your last evening together as a group!

Sunday - October 1st: (Breakfast)

Portsmouth, NH - Home

Enjoy one last *Breakfast* at the *Inn* prior to check-out and departure for home. Stops will be made for the necessary rest and comfort breaks. Lunch and a quick dinner stop on your own will also be made en route to Richmond.
